
Easter Bunny Hat




Easter is celebrated each year on the first Sunday after the first full moon after the vernal equinox. The name "Easter" is thought to come from "Eostre", the Germanic goddess of spring. Easter is widely celebrated in commemoration of the resurrection of Christ, and of the coming of spring.


In the spring, rabbits give birth to large litters. As a result, rabbits have been seen as symbols of life and prosperity since ancient times, and have often played important roles in spring festivals. Tradition has it that on Easter a rabbit called the Easter Bunny delivers Easter Eggs, a symbol of birth and creation.

Note: this hat is sized for an adult. To make a childsized hat, print the pattern reduced to about 85%.








Glue reverse side. *This part is EYES.













Cut line
