



AT HOME LABORATORY: PROJECT 2

ATOM STORAGE BOX

1. Shrink this image down so that it fits onto a piece of paper. Print it out - preferably in color. It is recommended that you use a thick card stock; regular paper will be too weak to actually hold anything.
2. Cut out the two images. Crease and fold all joints and flaps towards the unprinted side of the paper.
3. Use glue (always use outside or in a well ventilated area) to adhere tabs 'A', 'B', 'C', and 'D' to the inside - non printed side - of the neighboring flaps. Your main box portion is complete.
4. Repeat step '3' for the lid portion. You have just created your very own atom storage box. Now try shrinking the image even further to create smaller boxes.
