


A Assemble the head

Use pattern: Page2/Page3.

① Cut out A1 by cutting along the lines.

★ Cut along the line marked




② Make a mountain fold on A1.

★ Trace along the mountain fold line with a pencil, scoring it to make it easier to fold.



③ The parts will be easier to assemble if curled.


★ Using the photo as a guide, apply pressure with the palm of your hand, gradually curling the paper in the direction of the arrow.



④ Add a slight curl to A1 when attaching it.

★ Attach the triangular glue tabs so that the front side becomes convex.

★ Using the photo as a guide, attach in the direction of the arrow.

Scissors
Paste, or woodwork glue
Stencil pen, or bodkin

◆ The Assembly instructions are divided into seven blocks: A (head), B (body), C (legs), D (dress), E (ribbon), F (arm), and G (veil and bouquet).


Follow the instructions for each block to assemble your teddy bear.

◆ ★ marks a basic assembly technique that remains the same regardless of the part. Instructions are printed only for the first instance.


<Caution>

- ✘ Keep scissors and glue away from small children.
- ✘ Be careful not to cut your fingers when using scissors.


⑤ Cut out A2 and A3, curl them and glue the triangular glue tabs, attaching each to A1.




⑧ Assemble A8 and attach to the head. Assemble A9.



⑥ Assemble A4 and attach it to A5.



⑦ Assemble A6 and A7 in the same way and attach the ears to the head.




***Note:** The completed A9 will be attached in the last step.


B Assemble the body

Use pattern: Page4/Page5.


① Assemble B1.




② Assemble B2.




③ Attach B1 and B2 together.



② Attach C1 through C7 together.



④ Assemble B3 and attach it to B1 to complete the body.




*Note: The completed head will be fitted in a later step.


C Assemble the legs

Use pattern: Page6/Page7.


① Assemble parts C2 through C7.



③ Assemble parts C8 through C14 in the same way.




④ Fit both legs to the completed body.



D Assemble the dress


Use pattern: Page8/Page9/Page10/Page11.

① Attach D1 and D2. Assemble D3 and D4 in the same way, then attach D1 and D3.




② Attach D5 and D6 to the skirt.


Match up the shapes of the glue spots and then stick them together.




③ Assemble D8 and attach it to D7.




④ Attach D7 and D8 to the skirt.



⑤ Assemble D9 and D10 and stick them together.




⑥ Attach D9,D10 to the skirt,to complete the dress.




E Assemble the ribbon

Use pattern: Page12.


① Assemble E1.



② Assemble E2 and attach it to E3.
Attach E4 and E5 in the same way.



③ Attach E2, E3, E4, E5 to E1.



④ Attach the ribbon to the dress.




⑤ Fit the dress over the body, to complete the ribbon.




F Assemble the arm

Use pattern: Page13.

① Assemble parts F1 through F6.




② Attach F1 through F6 together.




③ Assemble parts F7 through F12 in the same way.



④ Fit both arms to the completed body.




⑤ Fit the head to the body and attach A9.




G Assemble the veil and bouquet

Use pattern: Page14/Page15.


① Assemble G1, G2 and G3, G4 and attach G5.




② Assemble G6 and attach to the ribbon.




③ Attach G7, G8, G9 and G10 and attach it to the ribbon.



④ Attach G11, G12, G13 and G14.



⑤ Assemble G15 and attach it to G11.



⑥ Assemble parts G16 to G27 in the same way as the flowers for the veil, then stick them onto G15.



⑦ Assemble G28 and stick it on behind the leaf of the bouquet. Attach the bouquet to the veil and you're finished!
